

PRACTICE ICE INSTRUCTIONS

PREPRELIMINARY THROUGH SENIOR

PRACTICE ICE: Practice ice will be available starting Monday, June 19, 2017, and if numbers warrant will start on Sunday, June 18, 2017.

OFFICIAL ICE is available to skaters competing in the freeskating &/or short program only events. Official ice is **NOT** available for spins, jumps, artistic, or compulsories. Official sessions will be 30 minutes in length and if assigned to you, your music will be played. Skaters entering two levels of the combined event or the short program only event may be limited to one official session per event depending on time constraints. For example, a Juvenile skater entering both Juvenile & Intermediate Short Program Only may be assigned official ice only for the Juvenile Short Program.

WARM-UP ICE is available only for levels **JUVENILE & ABOVE competing** in freeskating &/or short program only events. Warm-up sessions are 20 minutes in length, will most likely NOT be on the competition surface, & music will not be played.

You may request only 1 official session and 1 warm-up session per segment of each event entered. Official ice is available at a cost of \$18 **per person per session** for singles and solo dance, and \$20 **per person per session** for pairs and partner dance. Warm-up ice is available at a cost of \$15 **per person per session** for singles and solo dance, & \$17 **per person per session** for pairs and partner dance.

ADDITIONAL ICE may be purchased if available. These sessions are \$18 per person per session for singles and solo dance, and \$20 per person per session for Pairs & Partner Dance. These sessions are 30 minutes in length and may or may not take place on the competition surface. There is no guarantee that your music will be played on these additional sessions. Music order will be based on a random draw & not all skaters will get their music played. Any remaining practice ice will be available at the practice ice desk throughout the competition. Ice will be sold on a first come first served basis.

****IF YOU ARE COMPETING IN AN ELIMINATION ROUND FREESKATING EVENT, PLEASE DO NOT REQUEST PRACTICE ICE PAST THE DATE OF YOUR ELIMINATION ROUND COMPETITION EVENT UNLESS YOU ARE ALSO COMPETING IN ADDITIONAL EVENTS.****

****FINAL ROUND PRACTICE ICE WILL BE SOLD UPON THE COMPLETION OF THE LAST ELIMINATION ROUND GROUP FOR YOUR LEVEL AT THE PRACTICE ICE DESK AT GATE A.****
